



Start your Charlottetown adventure bright and early, ready to explore. First stop: Cape Egmont, where the mesmerizing Bottle Houses made of recycled glass await, surrounded by vibrant gardens. Next, visit Tyne Valley, a charming village celebrated for its oyster festival and historic appeal. Journey onward to O'Leary to discover the Canadian Potato Museum and sample local potato treats. Pause at West Cape for breathtaking coastline views, then climb the West Point Lighthouse for a stunning panorama.

After a refreshing lunch, continue to North Cape via Miminegash to learn about seaweed harvesting at the Irish Moss Interpretive Centre. Visit Skinner's Pond to honor Stompin' Tom Connors, then explore Tignish and the beautiful St. Simon & St. Jude Church. Finally, reach Mill River Resort to unwind after a day filled with culture, nature, and unforgettable sights.

Visit the Anne of Green Gables Museum in Park Corner to see Anne's Room and the Lake of Shining Waters. Enjoy a horsedrawn carriage ride through the storybook landscape.
